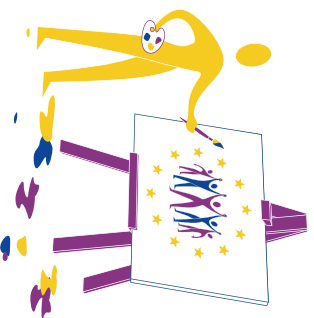


A **Family Justice Center** (FJC) is a co-located multiagency, multidisciplinary center where public and private agencies assign staff members to provide services to survivors of domestic violence, child abuse and sexual violence from one location.

The overall goal of a Family Justice Center is to ensure that survivors have access to all needed services, to enhance their safety, to empower them and increase offender accountability.

The most important characteristic is the client-centered approach: The survivors are central to the FJC model.

A place where professionals come together and survivors come first: ONE SAFE PLACE.



The European Alliance for Hope and Empowerment – European Family Justice Center Alliance

(EFJCA) is a legal entity and the officially recognized network of the Family Justice Centers in Europe. It promotes the FJC model and provides a central platform for its members. As an umbrella organization the EFJCA exchanges knowledge, experiences and good practices among its members.

The Alliance provides the Family Justice Centers and affiliated multi-agency models with customized tools, specialized methodologies and on-the-job-training, which leads to continuous improvement of the Centers and helps them to create better resources for survivors of domestic violence, child abuse and sexual violence.
