Safety

- 1. Safety plan including all family members
- 2. Not only safety planning at the start, ongoing check of the safety
- 3. In severe/high risk cases: High risk team
- 4. Involving social network in safeguarding and breaking social isolation

MAIN FEATURES OF FJC (1)

- Survivors don't need to tell their story to many different persons and agencies
- More information about the actions taken in the approach, the case manager has an overall view
- Reduce the number of domestic/family violence, serious incidents and murders
- Reduce child abuse incidents

MAIN FEATURS OF FJC (2)

- Quicker response is possible when new incidents , threats or changing circumstances occur
- Security is increased within a FJC
- Within the FJC there is a clear vision about the problem




Saving Lives - Reducing Costs

1 domestic violence murder will cost approximately £1.1 million



1 domestic violence murder prevented per year would provide savings equal to the total costs required to run the Family Justice Center for a year – including all key partner agency staffing costs
